







Tarsus Museum, which was opened in the Kubat Pasha Madrasa in 1971, has been serving in the 75th Year Cultural Center Complex since 2000, while it was put into service in the new building known as the Old Courthouse, which was restored and landscaped in the last month of 2020. The new museum, where the artefacts unearthed in the archaeological excavations around Tarsus and those purchased are exhibited, has two floors. In the halls on the ground floor, artefacts from the Paleolithic, Neolithic, Chalcolithic, Bronze, Iron, Archaic-Classical and Hellenistic Periods are exhibited. There is also a thematic hall in the corridor where artefacts from the Roman and Eastern Roman Periods are exhibited. In the upper floor section of the museum; artefacts from Donuktaş Temple, Cleopatra, Roman, Eastern Roman Periods, coins from different periods, 2 thousand 23 artefacts from the Islamic Period to the Republican Period are exhibited. There are also all necessary social facilities from the mosque to the gift shop, cafe, baby care room, elevator for our disabled citizens, specialized library and conference hall.







From the Prehistoric Period to the Hellenistic Period, from the Bronze House Animation Room to the Seven Sleepers Animation, from the Roman and Eastern Roman Mixed Hall to the Islamic Period Narration, from Tarsus Culinary Culture to Yoruk and Clothing Culture, there are sections and animations that reflect the periodical features, lives, history and cultures. We are waiting for our visitors on a cultural and historical journey that will take place by seeing, feeling and learning, supported by visual and auditory systems.
